### **VACATION STRATEGIES**

Before leaving on vacation, don't forget to get a house check completed with the Ames Police Department. You can do this by calling the Police Desk at

It is also important to make sure that you have made arrangements with a trusted neighbor or friend to check the interior of your house daily. Every year, someone in Ames seems to have a water pipe rupture or an electrical system failure that causes extensive damage within the house. An inside check can help minimize this cost.

While the person is inside checking, it is important to have them alternate lights set on timers and retrieve mail and newspapers and other types of hand-outs which seem to grow on doorsteps when the residents are away. A radio alarm clock set to play during the evening hours may give the house the sound that someone is there as well as the look that comes from lights on timers.

If you have an answering machine, do not leave messages on the recorder such as, "On vacation until September 1st. Call back then." The best message, even for daily use, is something like, "We can't get to the phone right now." A familiar pattern for burglars looking for targets of opportunity is to call a residence to see if anyone is home. This type of message makes it impossible for the potential burglar to tell if you are gone for the day, gone on vacation, or simply busy in another part of the house.

Just before leaving, walk around your house once to visually check doors and windows. Unplug your electric garage door opener, as electrical storms can cause the door to open, giving unauthorized access to your residence.
