IT'S THAT TIME AGAIN--for giving and receiving, and shopping, shopping, shopping! And home electronics--from video games to home theater paraphernalia to home office hardware and software--are on everyone's wish list. Finding the right stuff at the right prices can fray the nerves of even the most ardent shopper.

Happily, there's good news this holiday season. Many manufacturers and retailers are coming to the aid of frustrated technophiles with toll-free numbers, and improved sales help. Circuit City, an electronic superstore, offers the following sure-fire guide to stress-free shopping.

- Be prepared: Before you set foot in a store, know what you want, how much you are willing to pay, and where the product will be used.
- Shop at a store featuring knowledgeable sales help who are available to answer questions. A good salesperson should be up-to-date with the latest technology and be able to explain it in terms you can understand.
- Consider logistics. How will you get the product home? Does the store offer convenient evening and weekend delivery? How will the product be serviced? Does the retailer offer product service?
- Find out the manufacturer's return policy. Although you expect to be happy with your purchase, it is possible a particular product may need to be returned. It is also important to know the details of a store's return policy so you don't wind up with something that you don't want. Do they have a 30-day return policy? If so, does it apply to all products or do limitations exist for some items, such as camcorders or big-screen T.V.s? Do you need your receipt? Can a product be returned to any store in a chain? Can you return it for cash or store credit only?
- Choose a store that will support your purchase after the sale, especially if it is intended as a gift. Many times you may understand how to operate a product in the store, but when you return home, new questions arise.
