#### The Fountains

If you have visited Moore Memorial Park within the last few weeks, you may have noticed that two fountains have been installed in the pond. ## **Bloomington Railroad Crossing Concerns**

Concerns have been raised by residents about the Bloomington Railroad Crossing. Local area residents were concerned because no railroad crossing warning devices had been placed other than signage and pavement marking devices since the street was paved.

Of particular concern, is the safety of the crossing during nighttime periods, since there was no street lighting in the area and apparently the trains are very difficult to see.

The City has taken immediate action by placing street lights on both the east and west sides of the crossing to improve safety for now. This spring, automated railroad crossing arms will be installed for further safety. City Manager Steve Shainker has confimed this will happen in the spring.
