Held at the Library. A rundown of the year past was given and Reiny Friedrich reported the northeast corner of Northridge is now zoned as single family dwelling. The Taylor farm will be developed as a "village concept" & will include an elementary school, 7 acres of commercial space and possibly a neighborhood medical clinic. Stange Road will be extended to Bloomington, Bloomington will be paved from the tracks to GWCarver ending in a "T" intersection. Carver will be widened to 4 lane and downgraded to handle local traffic.
